

ISANA NZ PROFESSIONALISATION AWARD 2020



The most common definition of Professionalism is a social process by which any trade or occupation transforms itself into a true “profession of the highest integrity and competence.” The ISANA NZ Professionalisation Award recognises a member of our profession who has exemplified and demonstrated this commitment to the international education profession through integrity and competence. The Award will be given to a person demonstrating an innate sense of morality and ethics, as well as a desire to continue to learn and improve. They will have an unwavering commitment to a role in an international student department.

Nominations for this scholarship must be received by **5pm Friday, 4th December.**

The winner of the ISANA NZ Professionalisation Award 2020 will receive free ISANA NZ membership for 2021 and an ISANA NZ Professionalisation Award trophy. They will be recognized in the next ISANA NZ newsletter and on social media.

Rules & Criteria for the ISANA NZ Award

- The nominee may or may not be ISANA NZ member(s).
- The nominator(s) may or may not be ISANA NZ member(s).
- The identity of the nominator(s) will not be made public and will not be made known to the nominees by ISANA NZ (in case the nominator(s) prefer to remain anonymous).
- To nominate someone, the nominator(s) must submit a written brief (up to 500 words long) explaining why the nominee deserves to win the award.
- All nominations (including the written brief, name and contact details of nominator(s), and name and contact details of nominee) must be received by ISANA NZ no later than 5pm Friday 4th December 2020.
